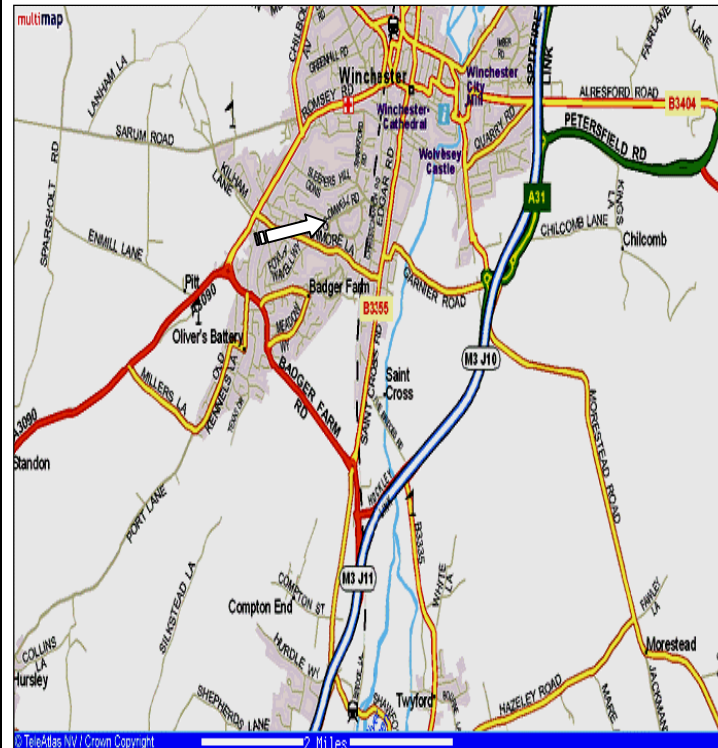

INFORMATION LEAFLET

Welcome to Badger Farm Community Centre where a wide variety of activities and events take place on a daily basis. See inside this leaflet for more details. The Centre has a warm and welcoming atmosphere, all rooms are bright and airy and of a good size. The four rooms available for hire provide an excellent venue and good value for money.

The Battery - The main hall which will hold up to 180 people. Suitable for wedding receptions, christenings, parties or sporting activities. The Social Club bar can also be hired with the hall.

The Bushfield - A carpeted room which will hold up to 70 people. Suitable for business meetings, exercise groups and parties. Access to the Social Club bar can also be hired with this room.

The Whiteshute - A room which will hold up to 40 people. Suitable for children's parties and meetings.

The Warren - A small room holding up to 30 people and suitable for meetings. This room can be opened up with The Bushfield for extra space and the Social Club bar is also available for hire.

All rooms hired include the use of a fully equipped kitchen. We are also able to offer Internet access in our Bushfield and Whitshute Rooms and use of equipment such as flip charts, screen, urn and projector at no extra cost. A LITTLE ABOUT OUR HISTORY



The Community Centre is leased by The Badger Farm Parish Council to The Badger Farm and Oliver's Battery Residents' Community Association. It was opened in November 1986. Since that time the Association has encouraged diverse activities within the building. Groups regularly using its facilities include a wide age range from babes-in-arms to the elderly covering areas such as art, dancing, exercise, sport, toddlers/pre-school, special needs and wildlife. There is also a thriving Social Club open to residents of both Badger Farm and Oliver's Battery parishes. Residents of adjacent parishes may also be members.

The Association has charitable status and is managed by a Board of volunteer Trustees. In addition, there are three employees: a Caretaker, a Bookings Secretary and a Financial Advisor. All of its spare income is spent on maintaining the building and updating facilities in line with current legislation and health and safety directives.
